## **Sewing classes for all kids and teens**

**Registration:** registration folder will include shop and class information, parent authorization and release to be signed before first class meeting, class rules and policies, teacher information and contact number.

**Class fees** include supplies (fabric, thread, findings, patterns) Therefore, class fees MUST be paid not later than one (1) week in advance. Classes are limited in size to afford individualized attention. If a class is missed, a makeup within one month must occur or class fee will be forfeited.

**Cancellation:** like class fees, cancellation MUST not be less than one week prior to class meeting.

### **Sew After School: Ages 9-12**

This class is perfect for beginners! This two-part class will teach the kids to use their machine by mastering skills such as threading and basic machine controls. An age appropriate project will be done in every class and is included in your class fee. We will be making pj pants, American Girl Doll clothing, crossbody bags, pillowcases, etc. Our first project will be a fun drawstring bag: perfect for carrying your child's future sewing projects!

**Requirements:** Bring in your own sewing machine with the foot control and all of it's feet.
